**A Resource For Prayer Calls, Personal Devotion, Or Small Group Intercession.**

## **Week 1: Local Judges & County Courts**

**Focus:** Integrity, Wisdom, And Justice In Local Systems

**Scripture:** Micah 6:8 – “To Act Justly And To Love Mercy And To Walk Humbly With Your God.”

**Prayer Points:**

- Pray For Your Local Judges By Name (Research Them If Needed).
- Ask God To Give Them Wisdom In Handling Complex Civil And Criminal Cases.
- Intercede Against Injustice, Corruption, Or Undue Pressure In Local Courtrooms.
- Pray For Righteous Prosecutors, Public Defenders, And Clerks To Be A Light In The Legal System.
- Ask God To Raise Up God-Fearing Believers Into Local Judicial Roles.

**Application:** Choose One Local Court Or Judge To Pray For Daily This Week. Write Their Name In A Journal

## **Week 2: Federal Courts & The U.S. Supreme Court**

**Focus:** Constitutional Integrity And National Impact

**Scripture:** Proverbs 21:1 – “The King’s Heart Is In The Hand Of The Lord... He Directs It Like A Watercourse Wherever He Pleases.”

**Prayer Points:**

- Pray By Name For Each U.S. Supreme Court Justice And Their Clerks.
- Intercede For Federal Appeals Court Judges Who Shape Long-Term Legal Precedent.
- Ask God To Root Out Judicial Activism And Restore Original Constitutional Interpretation.
- Pray For Upcoming Or Pending Cases That Have Spiritual And Cultural Consequences.
- Ask For Courage And Conviction Among Justices To Fear God, Not Man.

**Application:** Look Up A Recent Or Upcoming Federal Case And Pray For God’s Justice To Prevail.

## Week 3: Religious Liberty & Free Speech

**Focus:** Protection Of Fundamental Freedoms

**Scripture:** Galatians 5:1 – “It Is For Freedom That Christ Has Set Us Free...”

**Prayer Points:**

- Pray For Judges To Uphold The First Amendment With Clarity And Boldness.
- Intercede For Believers And Churches Facing Legal Battles For Living Out Their Faith.
- Pray For Righteous Attorneys And Ministries Defending Religious Freedom In The Courts.
- Ask God To Frustrate The Plans Of Those Who Seek To Silence Truth Or Restrict Speech.
- Cover School Boards, City Councils, And Administrators In Prayer For Boldness And Wisdom.

**Application:**

Share An Encouraging Case Or Testimony Of A Win For Religious Liberty With Your Prayer Group.

## Week 4: Youth, Law Schools, And Future Judges

**Focus:** Discipling The Next Generation Of Legal Leaders

**Scripture:** Psalm 119:9 – “How Can A Young Person Stay On The Path Of Purity? By Living According To Your Word.”

**Prayer Points:**

- Pray For Young Believers In Law School To Be Bold, Equipped, And Uncompromising.
- Intercede For Christian Law Professors And Mentors Influencing Students.
- Ask God To Raise Up A New Wave Of Originalist, God-Honoring Attorneys And Judges.
- Pray For Biblical Worldview Education Among Youth And College Ministries.
- Cover Legal Fellowships (Like Blackstone Or Alliance Defending Freedom) In Prayer.

**Application:**

Reach Out To A Law Student Or Young Professional In Your Church. Offer To Pray For Them This Week.

## Week 5: (Use In Months With 5 Weeks): National Revival In The Courts

**Focus:** Spiritual Awakening In America’s Judiciary

**Scripture:** Psalm 85:6 – “Will You Not Revive Us Again, That Your People May Rejoice In You?”

**Prayer Points:**

- Pray For Personal Salvation And Revival Among Judges, Clerks, And Court Officials.
- Ask The Holy Spirit To Penetrate Courthouses With Truth, Conviction, And Repentance.
- Pray For Bold Witness And Ministry From Believers Working In The Legal System.
- Intercede For A Cleansing Of Unjust Laws And A Return To Righteousness In Legal Codes.
- Declare God's Justice And Mercy Over America’s Legal Foundations.

**Application:**

Hold A Special Prayer Night Or Zoom Call To Focus On Revival In The Legal And Judicial Realms.
