

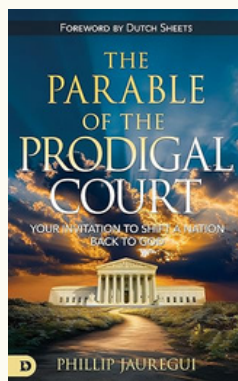

Prayers for JAGf

- That the Lord would position and prepare JAG and JAGF for the nomination and confirmation of a new Supreme Court Justice if there is a vacancy on the Court this summer.
- That the Lord would use [The Parable of the Prodigal Court](#) to call a new generation of prayer warriors to intercede on behalf of the court and to equip seasoned intercessors.



Supreme Court News

Join us in praying that righteousness and justice would prevail in response to the following news:

- Tragically, the [U.S. Supreme Court overruled a lower court injunction which temporarily banned](#) the abortion pill via mail. Before 2023, the abortion pill required a doctor's prescription. More than 60% of abortions take place because of mifepristone, accounting for more than half a million lives lost in the United States every year. Pray that this illegal and immoral practice will be found unconstitutional as the case moves forward through federal courts.
- The U.S. Supreme Court ruled that [racial gerrymandering can only be used by States in narrow cases](#). This decision has led to the redrawing of Congressional Districts in multiple states which will impact the results of the 2026 midterm election.

Little v. Hecox & West Virginia v. BPJ

On January 13, 2026, the Supreme Court heard oral arguments in Little v. Hecox & West Virginia v. BPJ regarding state laws that protect women's sports by requiring participants to join sports teams only based on biological sex.

1. That the Supreme Court rules that both laws are Constitutional and are necessary to protect women.
2. That the Supreme Court recognizes the God-given differences between men and women.
3. That the Supreme Court directly rejects "transgenderism" as a protected sex classification under the Equal Protection Clause.

Prayers for the Court

1. Pray that the Lord strengthens and uphold the Justices for such a time as this, and that any Justice that steps down will be replaced by a person who fears the Lord and advances the cause of righteousness in the Nation.
2. Pray that the Lord delivers the Justices from every snare and plot, that He blesses their security personnel with extraordinary watchfulness, and preserves their lives.
