Prayers for JAGf

- The National Consecration of Our Courts (October 4-5) event is one month away. Pray that prayers for the Supreme Court would be directed by the Word of God and the Holy Spirit. Pray that the Lord would bring the right intercessors to join us.
- The next Supreme Court term will begin directly after the NCC Event. Pray that JAGF, and our President, Phillip Jauregui, would have discernment on how best to prepare for the next set of Supreme Court cases.

Supreme Court News

Join us in praying that righteousness and justice would prevail in response to the following news:

- On August 24, 2026, the [Supreme Court stopped an injunction brought against the President Trump's mail-in ballot executive order \(No. 14399\)](#), because, in part, the Executive Order did not create a final rule that would impact the States. This is likely not the last legal action involving the executive order.
- Our friends at Bound4Life are hosting a prayer event called [All To The Wall](#) from September 5-7. Intercessors will be contending for LIFE and praying for renewed restrictions on the abortion pill in a significant case being heard by the 5th Circuit Court of Appeals. Keep the attendees in prayer. 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Case in Focus

Nathan v. Alamo Heights Independent School District (Pending)

On August 17, several Texas families, represented by the ACLU, filed a petition with the Supreme Court challenging the Constitutionality of a Texas law which required the Ten Commandments to be displayed in every public school classroom. In the decision being appealed, the 5th Circuit ruled that the Texas law did not violate the Constitution, because the law did not violate the establishment of religion clause, and the law did not prohibit the free exercise of religion.

JAGf's focus is to pray for each Justice to rightly acknowledge God's role in the founding of the nation. There has been positive movement on this issue. In the prayer case involving Coach Kennedy, the Supreme Court rejected a previous "rewriting" of the Constitution. Instead of applying a secular standard, the Supreme Court stated that the Establishment Clause must be interpreted by 'reference to historical practices and understandings.' Under this updated standard, the Court has the opportunity to acknowledge the importance of the Ten Commandments to our nation.

Topics for Prayer

1. That the Supreme Court would accept the case and find the Texas law Constitutional.
2. Most importantly, that the opinion would recognize the importance of God's role in our government and acknowledge that prior Supreme Court rulings removing God from schools were incorrect.

Prayers for the Court

1. Pray that the Justices will be able to rest and recuperate before the next term. Pray that the Lord encounters every single Justice in a new way and that they would personally pray and call on the Name of Jesus.

2. Pray that the Justices would recognize that the United States was founded as a Christian nation and that our ideals are ineffective without reliance on the Giver of those ideals.

3. Pray that the Lord protects the Justices from every plot, that He blesses their security personnel, and preserves their lives.
